Roger Washington is UCOR's General Counsel for the East Tennessee Technology Park. Originally from South Carolina, Roger attended New York University Law School. Upon finishing his education, Roger returned to South Carolina to work as an in-house counsel for an affiliate of the National Education Association. Roger later worked in the Employment Training Division of the Governor's Office. Both of these positions included a significant amount of involvement in public employment and administrative law.

Roger subsequently accepted a direct commission as an officer in the Army Judge Advocate General's Corps. Following his initial tours as a prosecutor and training officer, Roger specialized in government contract law. His assignments in this field included contract appeals litigation, contract formation and administration, suspension and debarment, Chief of Contract Law (HQ, U.S. Army Europe) and Associate General Counsel (Acquisitions), Army Office of General Counsel. During his Judge Advocate General's Corps career, Roger completed studies for an environmental law degree at George Washington University.

In 2004, Roger retired from active duty in the rank of colonel and joined AECOM at the Savannah River Site as Senior Procurement Attorney. He later served in other positions supporting various business units. Since 2008, Roger has supported the Nuclear and Environment Strategic Business Unit for international business development, Department of Energy and commercial contracts, and for general corporate matters. In 2015, Roger joined the AECOM Management Services headquarters in Germantown, Maryland.
