Roger Jarrell is UCOR's General Counsel. He previously served as UCOR's Government and Stakeholder Interface, responsible for communicating and coordinating with federal, state, and local officials on matters related to UCOR's cleanup contract with the Department of Energy (DOE). He was also involved in consolidating and managing UCOR's workforce development efforts.

Before joining UCOR, Roger served as the DOE Office of Environment Management's (EM) key interface with the Office of the Secretary and other senior members of Administration leadership. In that role, he was responsible for formulating cleanup strategies for a \$6.9 billion annual program, coordinating EM's communication strategy, and providing key leadership to the program.

Roger previously served as a legislative aide, political consultant, and elected Republican Party official in Lexington, Virginia. He was the 6th Virginia Congressional District Director for the Donald J. Trump for President Campaign and Chairman of the Rockbridge Area Republican Committee.
